NOUMEA CRUISE TERMINAL

Discover the Noumea Cruise Terminal: browse local crafts, book tours and transport with ease, enjoy free Wi-Fi, access helpful services (info desk, currency exchange ...), and explore an interactive space by New Caledonia Tourism to enhance your stay!



TOURISM OFFICE

Located in the Quays commercial centre (next to the Cruise Terminal) and at the Noumea Aquarium, the “Sud Tourisme” information office is open from Monday to Saturday (8 am -12 pm / 1pm-5pm). Sunday (8 am-12 pm).

SHOPPING & RESTAURANT

Dine and unwind at cafés and restaurants along Quai Ferry, Anse Vata, Baie des Citrons... plus top shopping spots in the City Centre and nearby malls. Just show your cruise card to unlock exclusive offers via our web portal (QR code).



OPENING HOURS AND SERVICES

Most shops close on Sundays and some on Saturday afternoons. Supermarkets open 8 am-8 pm (Mon-Sat) but also close Sunday afternoons. Meals are typically served 11:30am-1:30pm and 7pm-9:30pm, with last orders around 9 pm. Tipping is not required.

CURRENCY

Need cash for shopping? Exchange your AUD for Pacific Franc XPF at the Cruise Terminal desk (ID required, fixed Euro rate). Credit cards are widely accepted and ATMs available citywide.

HEALTH AND SECURITY

New Caledonia is a safe destination with modern infrastructure, world-class healthcare meeting French standards, and reliable emergency services, even at sea. No vaccinations are required, and tap water is safe to drink. Don't forget your sunscreen!

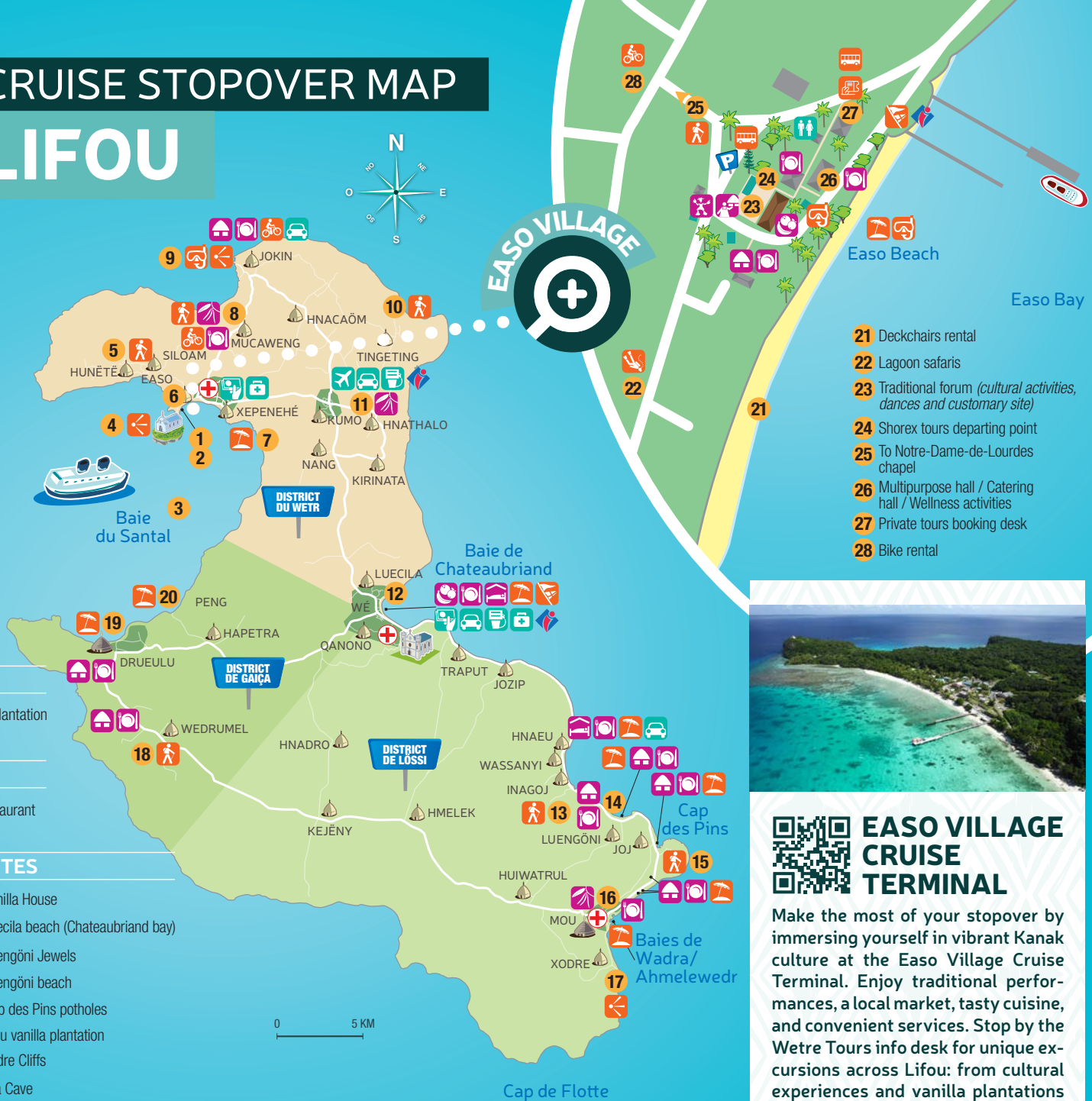

DO'S AND DON'TS ON CUSTOMARY LAND

Lifou is a customary land where Kanak traditions are deeply honoured and proudly shared. Please respect local customs by dressing modestly (bikinis are for the beach only) and avoiding oils before swimming to help protect the lagoon. Walking through tribes unaccompanied is not permitted;

cultural and natural sites must be visited with a guide. For tips and tours, visit the Easo Village information desk!

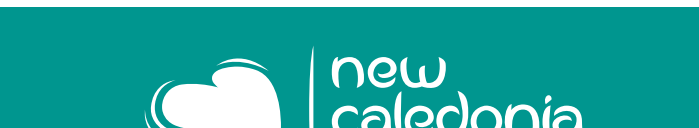
